## **Environmental Policy Statement**

Natural Generation supplies and installs renewable energy systems for domestic, commercial and community projects in the South West. These include micro-wind turbines, solar photovoltaic and solar hot water systems. The company is based at a small commercial unit in St Agnes near Truro but much of its work is undertaken on site at customers' premises.

At Natural Generation we recognise that whilst we are actively involved in installing renewable micro-generation systems, we still have our own carbon footprint.
